

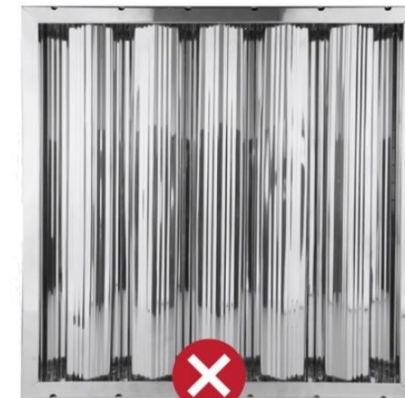
# FILTER CHANGE GUIDE

Frequency is subject to change during busy holiday and event periods

**LEAVING FILTERS TOO LONG RESTRICTS AIRFLOW, AND INCREASES CLEANING & FIRE RISK!  
TURN OFF ALL COOKING EQUIPMENT AND ALLOW TO COOL DOWN BEFORE REMOVING FILTERS**



GLOVES ARE ADVISABLE WHEN HANDLING FRAMES



**ABOVE FRYER / COMBI ETC.**

**ABOVE GRILL / HOTPLATE ETC.**

**RIGHT SIDE UP**

**WRONG SIDE UP**

**NO GREY STREAKS = TIME TO CHANGE**

**ALWAYS PLACE WOOL FILTER MEDIA ON THE SIDE FEATURING THE MESH & ENSURE BAFFLES RUN VERTICALLY (UP & DOWN) ON RE-INSTALLATION**
